Oxfordshire C&YP Survey 2007

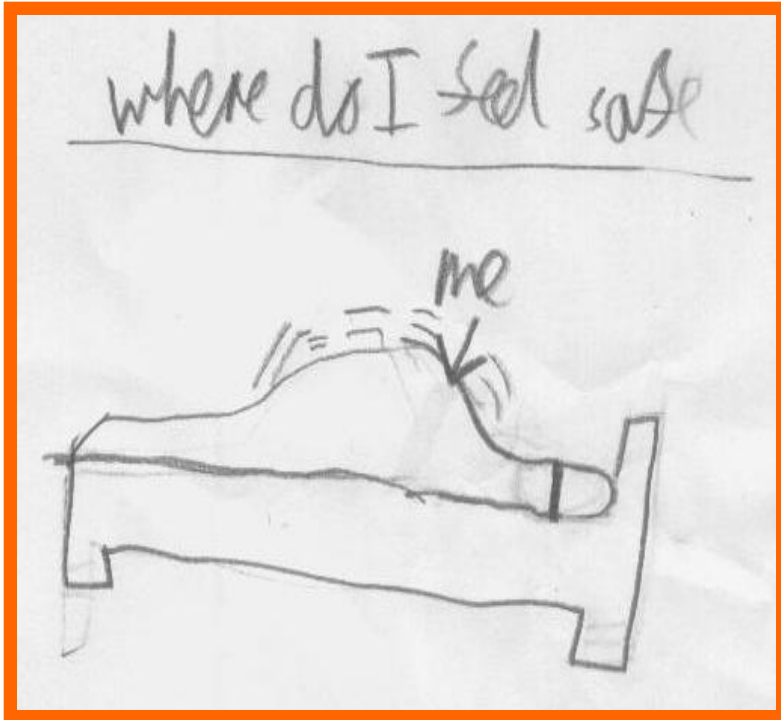
- **6,539 C&YP aged 4-16+ from 35 schools**
- **March – May 2007 – online primarily**
- **To better understand the experiences and views of C&YP and provide baseline data for CYPP**

Be Healthy

- 80% of all C&YP feel very/quite healthy
- Healthy eating has strong correlation with positive outcomes
- 31% Y7-11 feel stressed 2+ x p/w
- 9% of Y7-11 are regular smokers (2 + p/w)
- 52% of Y7-11 drink alcohol, 14% of Y7-11 2 + x p/w
- 16% of Y7-11 buy alcohol, 19% of Y10 buy alcohol
- Most say they receive enough info/advice



Stay Safe



- 51% of Y7-11 have been bullied, kicked, attacked, threatened or punched, called gay or racist names, or had something stolen (in or out of school)
- 15% of Y3-11 say they have bullied someone in the last year
- 71% always/sometimes feel safe at school – 9% never/not often feel safe (out of lessons) 6% don't (in lessons)
- 62% always and 19% sometimes feel safe at home – 3% don't often & 2% never do

Feeling safe at home ...

- Who you live with
- Where you live
- Ethnicity
- Caring responsibilities
- Alcohol – buy & get drunk more often
- Drugs – much more often
- Smoking – more often
- Feel less safe at school & in the community

Enjoy and Achieve

- 78% of all C&YP enjoy school sometimes/always – 9.6% never do
- 73% of all C&YP say they are doing very/quite well at school, 5% say they are doing very/quite badly
- 11% have bunked off school often/a few times
- 19% say schools listen to their views
- 42% think teaching is good
- Y3-11's do an average of 2.6 hrs of sport in school p/w
- 53% of secondary pupils say school toilets very/quite bad
- 51% of Y3-11 think there's enough to do and parks are good



Make a Positive Contribution

- **7% of Y3 – 11 participate in democratic decision-making**
- **32% know a lot/a little about UNCR**
- **Over half of all C&YP have recycled and litter picked, over 1/3 have volunteered**
- **Under a quarter know what their local council does**



Achieve Economic Well-Being

- **37% of Y7-11 have opportunities for work-related experiences in schools**
- **7% of Y7-11 want to leave school asap**
- **20% of Y7-11 have a PT job – averaging 5 hours p/w**
- **Over a quarter of Y7-11 are getting enough info/advice about futures, over a quarter are not**
