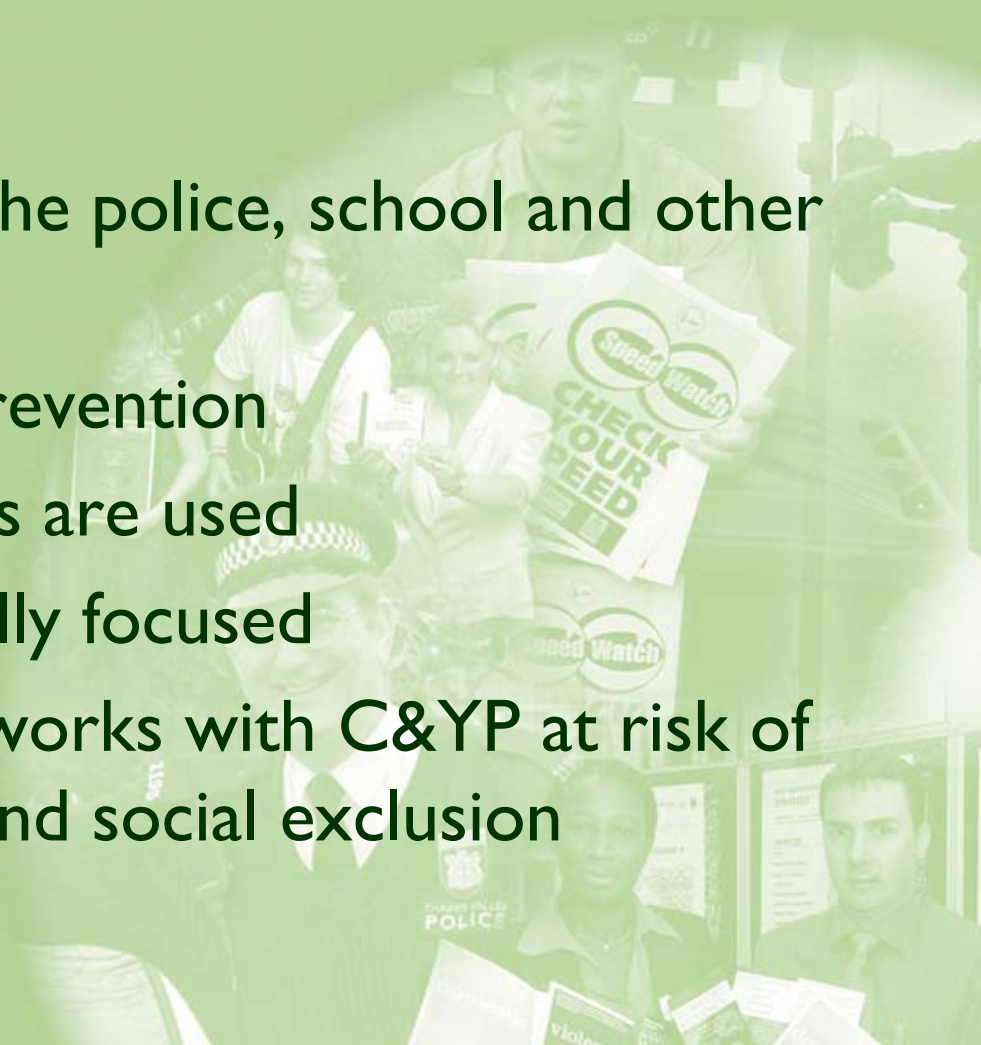

# Safer Schools Partnership

- A Partnership between the police, school and other agencies
- Early intervention and prevention
- Different delivery models are used
- Police officer operationally focused
- Identifies, supports and works with C&YP at risk of victimisation, offending and social exclusion



# SSP Aims

- Reduce crime. Anti social behaviour & victimisation
- Provide a safe & secure school community
- Engage with young people, challenge unacceptable behaviour & develop a respect for their community
- Ensure that young people remain in education

- No of pupils
- Unauthorised absences
- Crimes recorded at school
- No of pre court outcomes (per 1000)
- Number of arrests (per 1000)
- Scored to achieve grading

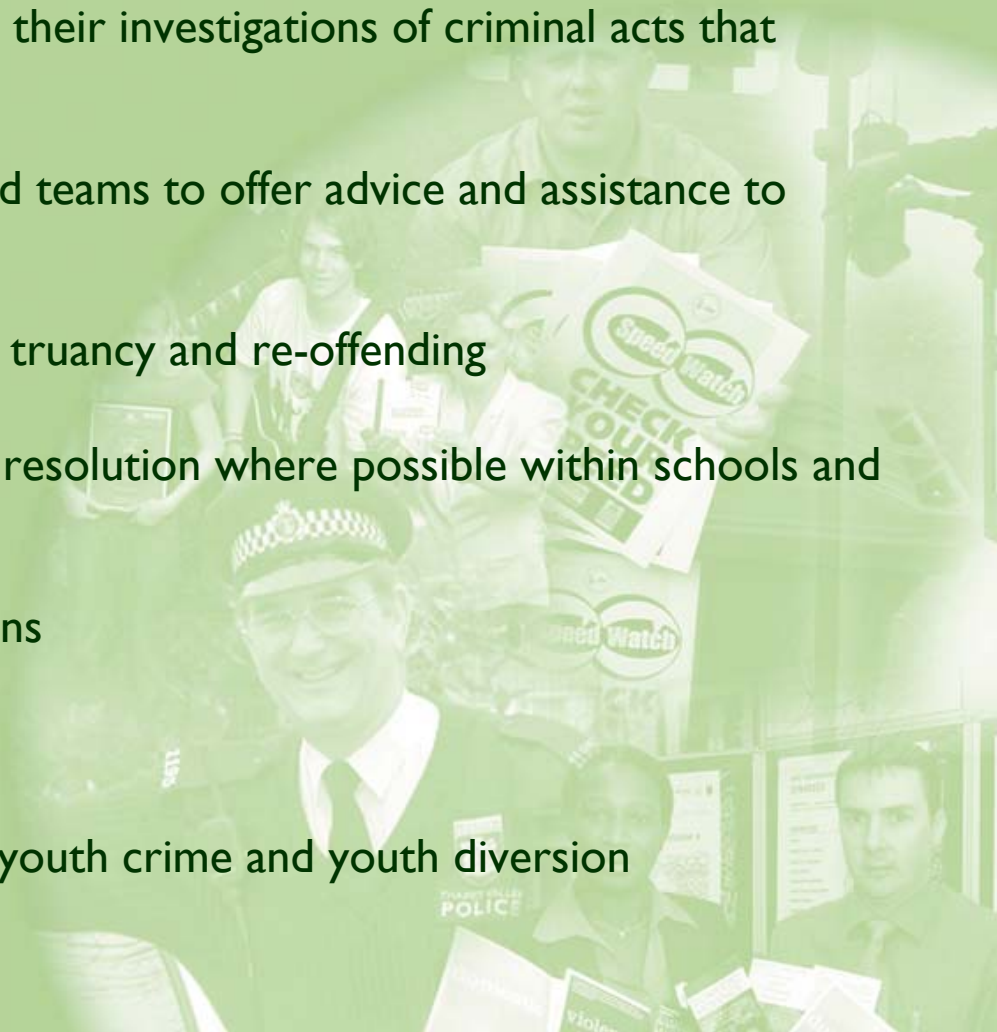

# My Responsibilities

- Support the Neighbourhood teams in their investigations of criminal acts that occur on school premises.
- Liaise and support the Neighbourhood teams to offer advice and assistance to schools
- Work to reduce offending behaviour, truancy and re-offending
- Assist in problem solving and conflict resolution where possible within schools and externally
- Point of contact for all youth provisions
- Multi agency youth intervention plans
- Research techniques for dealing with youth crime and youth diversion programmes



# Escalation of intervention

- The ethos of Thames Valley Police and its Community partners - an incremental approach to intervention.
- 3 main increments:
  1. Early response through diversion
  2. Intermediate response through intervention
  3. Final response through enforcement



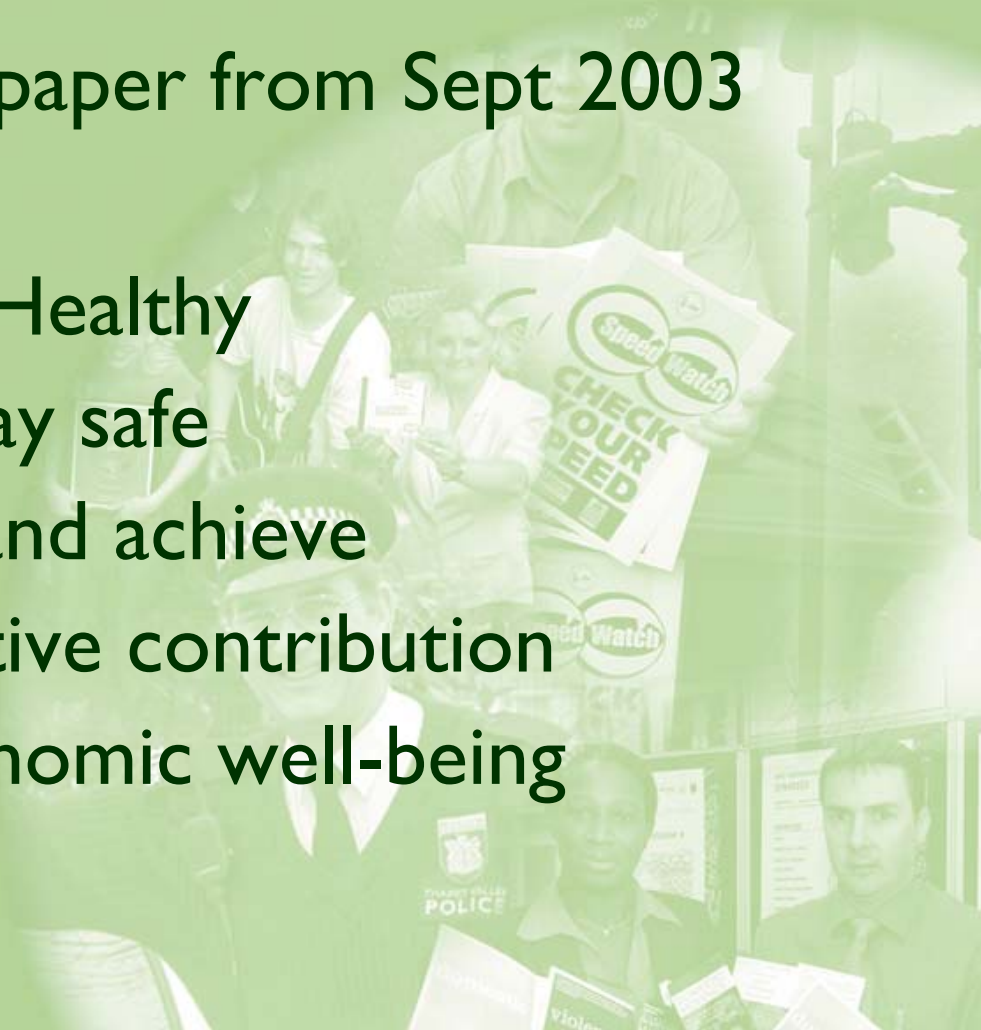
