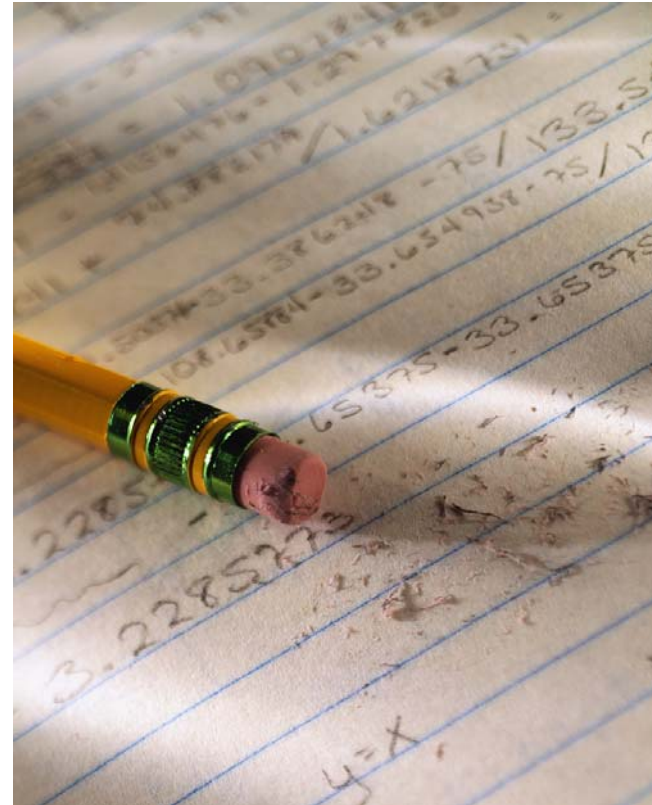
School Education Pack

- Courses on: Children and DV, Forced Marriage, DV and Law, Perpetrators and Confidential Routine Enquiry
- Safeguarding Courses

- Four running a year
- Supported by Women's Aid
- Aylesbury and Wycombe
- Evaluation of Pilot
